

## How to tie off our Paracord Biathlon Sling


1. Once you have the proper distance for the hook, mark the cord where it meets the end of the sling with a piece of masking tape. Then insert the ends of the cord through the second hole (one farthest away from the end of the sling) on the logo side



2. Bring the ends of the cord back through the first hole (one closest to the end of the sling) from the non-logo side



3. Spread the ends of the cord apart from each other and lay the looped end of the cord over the split you just made ensuring your mark from step 1 is aligned with the end of the sling



4. With the loop end between the running ends, tie an overhand knot



5. Tie another overhand knot completing a square knot



6. Now you can dress the knot and tighten it up.



7. The ends can be trimmed off with a scissors, if you do this, make sure you melt the ends of the cord to prevent fraying.
